

NOTICE OF CHANGE TO 2007 CALENDAR

CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION

In order to comply with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Storm Water Regulations, during the curbside leaf collection period (October 9th to December 8th) leaves /grass clippings/plant waste are to be placed in neat piles at the curb but not on the pavement nor less than 10 feet from a storm drain (catch basin) for collection. **Please assist Morris Township in complying with the NJDEP Regulations by not piling leaves on the pavement.**

Please also note, during the curbside leaf collection period, **brush cannot be placed in with the leaves or put out for regular garbage pickup.** During this period, residents may bring light brush to the Dept. of Public Works site on Jane Way, Monday – Saturday from 7 AM to 3 PM.

BATTERY RECYCLING

Dry cell and rechargeable type batteries are recyclable. Please do not put batteries in with garbage. Batteries are accepted at the Department of Public Works Recycling Depot located on Jane Way, Monday – Friday from 7 AM to 3 PM and Saturday from 7 AM to 4 PM.

Examples:

Alkaline Batteries: (AA, C, D 9 Volt)

Ni-Cad Batteries: (Cordless Power Tools, Cordless House Phone)

Lithium Batteries: (Cell Phone, Digital Camera, Watch, Hearing Aid)

GARBAGE COLLECTION

6 Item Limit (call 973-326-7398 Monday – Friday from 7 AM to 3:30 PM for large or extra items).

Wrap large glass doors with cardboard and tape.

Rugs must be cut, rolled, and tied into 4 ft. bundles with a **50 pound weight limit**.

Items shall not be more than 4 feet in length.

Standard 32 gallon garbage cans with lids and handles or durable plastic bags with a **50 pound weight limit are accepted**.

No construction materials.

No household hazardous waste.

Your cooperation is appreciated in keeping our sanitation workers health and safety in mind.
