ORDINANCE NO. 5-10

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 37 OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MORRIS ENTITLED “CONSTRUCTION CODES, UNIFORM”
SECTION 37-3, FEES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Morris, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, they being the governing body of said Township, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 37, Section 37-3 is amended to reflect the following revisions:

(2) Construction Office - Building Fee Schedule: Add Temporary Certificate of Occupancy - \$25.00 and Certificates of Compliance - \$50.00

(3) Construction Office - Fire Protection Fee Schedule: Alarm/Supervisory/Signaling: b. Each additional 50 - \$100.00

SECTION TWO: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: All Ordinances of the Township of Morris which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication thereof, as provided for by law.

TOWNSHIP OF MORRIS MORRIS COUNTY – NEW JERSEY ORDINANCE NO. -10

RE: AMENDING CHAPTER 71, SECTION 14 B AND C

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Morris as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 71 Section 14 B and C are amended so as to repeal existing subsections B and C and replace them in their entirety with new subsections as follows:

B. For each such non-residential use the amount of the service charge for each such use (multiple uses in one structure shall each constitute a separate use) shall be at the rate of \$6.75 per 1,000 gallons of metered water usage or metered sewage, with a minimum of \$565.00 per year, per use.

C. All users, other than residential, shall either have all water usage collectively or individually metered as determined by the municipal engineer, or shall have the discharge into the sewer system metered by an approved meter installed and maintained by the user. The Township of Morris shall have the right to inspect and check all meters and readings at any time. All sewage meters shall be calibrated on a quarterly basis by a firm approved by the Township of Morris, at the property owner's expense.

SECTION TWO:

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION THREE:

All ordinances of the Board of Health of the Township of Morris which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

ORDINANCE # -10

"AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 37 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MORRIS ENTITLED 'CONSTRUCTION CODES, UNIFORM"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Morris, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey be amended to include the following under:

CHAPTER 37, SECTION 37-1 CONSTRUCTION CODES, UNIFORM

D No garbage disposals allowed in the Township of Morris.

SECTION TWO: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: All Ordinances of the Township of Morris which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication thereof, as provided for by law.
