Bids for the contract must be submitted on standard proposal forms furnished by the Township of Morris in the manner designated therein and required by the Specifications. Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and must be delivered to the Morris Township Bid Committee, with the bid number and name, on April 8, 2010 at 10:00 A.M. **No bids shall be received by mail, only in person at the time, date, and place specified above.**

The Township reserves the right to reject any or all bids, if in its judgment the public interest will be best served by so doing.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27.

Pursuant to P.L. 2004, c. 57 (N.J.S.A. 52:32-44) all business organizations that conduct business with a New Jersey government agency are required to be registered with the State of New Jersey. Bidders and their subcontractors must submit proof with their bid that they are registered with the New Jersey Department of Treasury, Division of Revenue by submitting a copy of their Business Registration Certificate. Failure to provide the Business Registration Certificate prior to award of a contract will be cause for rejection of the bid as being nonresponsive.

The Township reserves the right to reject any or all bids, if in its judgment the public interest will be best served by doing so.
